An OSHA recordable injury occurs when an employee sustains an injury which requires medical treatment beyond first aid, as well as one that causes days away from work, restricted work or transfer to another job, or loss of consciousness or death.



The Fuquay-Varina facility reached this two-year safety milestone on March 18, 2017, attaining 120,506 man-hours without an injury. Their commitment to safety is commendable and employee engagement evident through the results they have achieved.

Fuquay-Varina Plant Manager Steve Zimny attributes this achievement to the team culture of "having each other's back". The Safety Program in Fuquay is team driven. Monthly safety themes and focus areas are reinforced daily and communicated through huddle meetings, white board discussions and stand downs to discuss opportunities that arise from hazard assessments and reports from their internal Risk Connect program.
