Oldcastle Precast Runs Colorado's Largest Corporate Challenge



LITTLETON, Colo. (AUGUST 2017) – Oldcastle Precast joined Colorado's largest Corporate Challenge by again participating in this year's 12th annual Colfax Marathon Corporate Cup Relay, presented by Denver's Kaiser

Permanente.

What's better than running 26.2 miles through the Mile-High City? Sharing the miles with co-workers! That's what Oldcastle Precast did. Three Oldcastle Precast teams displayed their



teamwork, camaraderie and community support by completing the Colfax Corporate Cup Relay Challenge. The Corporate Cup Relay has become a huge part of the event, attracting about 6,375 runners on five-person teams, breaking the distance (26.2 miles) into five legs ranging from 3.5 to 6.5 miles.

Overall 19,000 runners participated in this year's Colfax Marathon Event – The Ultimate Urban Tour – running the 26.2-mile marathon at an elevation of 5,280 feet, competing in the half marathon, the 10-miler or the Corporate Cup relay. With over 201 charities involved this year, this unique event, The Colfax Marathon Corporate Challenge, brings together thousands of people every year to have fun, be fit, and raise money for charities.

"Involving employees for a team building event, in addition to supporting a local charity, are the reasons why Oldcastle Precast continuously participates in this event," stated Rachael Schanel, sales representative of Oldcastle Precast. "This year we selected, H.O.P.E. (Helping Other People Excel), a non-profit program created by employees of the Arapahoe County Department of Human Services in Colorado, as the charity. Each Team of five employees ran the 26.2-mile Marathon Relay. Each team member ran a Relay Leg which varies in difficulty. The different Relay Legs were Leg 1: Urban River; Leg 2: No Groans at Sloans; Leg 3: Eclectic Mile High; Leg 4: Screaming Downhill; and finally Leg 5: Downtown River Trek.

The Oldcastle Precast teams started and finished in Denver's City Park. Ran through Mile High Stadium – home of the Denver Broncos! Ran through Denver Fire Station #1, along seven miles of rivers, lakes and bridges – including Sloan's Lake.
